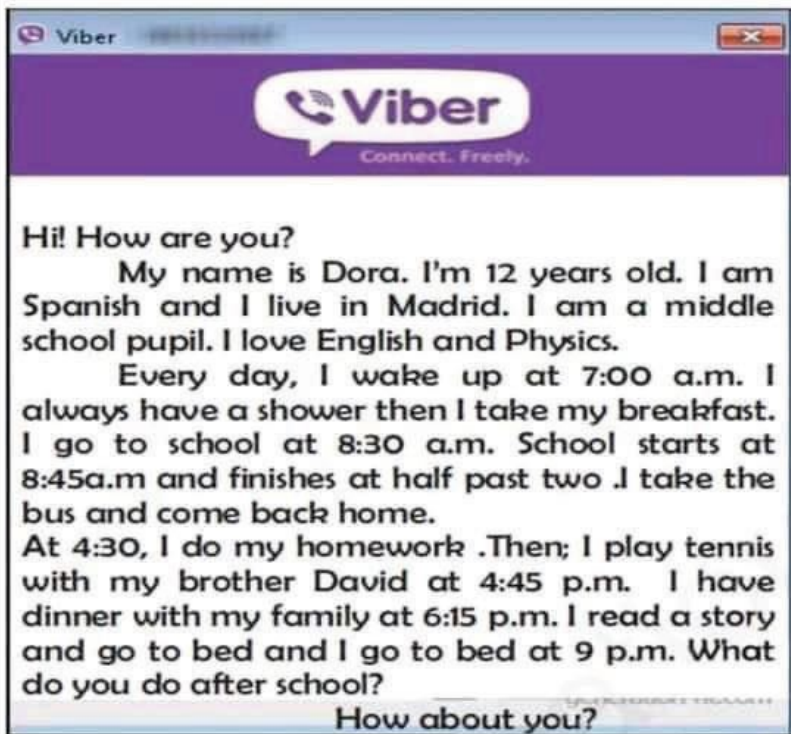


The 2nd English Exam

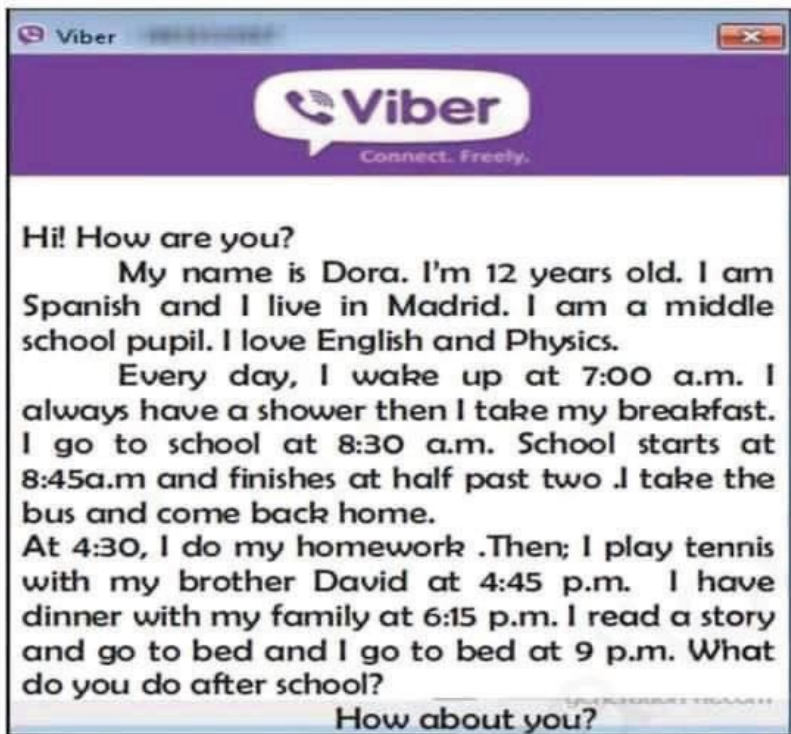
