The panda is an animal that has a body shape typical of bears. It lives in the forests of the West Central region of China.

It is a large, stocky animals. It measures up to 1.8m. The males weigh up to 160Kg and females are smaller. It lives around 20 years in wild and up to 30 years in captivity. The oldest captive is a female named Ming-Ming aged of 34. the panda feeds on vegetable matter, but it also eats small animals like birds and carrion. In captivity, they give them honey, fish, eggs ...etc. The black and white colour of the panda's coat provides effective camouflage in their snowy and rocky habitat. His woolly coat keeps it warm in cool forests. When it is in the wild, it is usually shy and solitary. But when it is in captivity, it becomes friendly and playful.

The panda is endangered for many reasons: loss of habitat, very low birth rate and poaching.
