After his graduation, he immigrated with his wife “Amal Attiah”, to Canada in 1978 seeking better life. Elfiky started looking for a job and within two days, he found two jobs. The best of those was a career of washing dishes in a modest hotel. He faced many challenges in his early life, but he never quit his dream. Elfiky moved forward in his career after washing dishes. He realized that he had to obtain a certified Canadian degree to have a better career. Therefore, he worked days and nights to make it happened. After eight years, he earned certificates with honours in Human Behaviour, Marketing and Sales Management. Furthermore, he became a ‘General Manager of five stars hotel in Montreal.

Ibrahim Elfiky started to specialize in the field of human development. Dr. Elfiky trained thousands of people in his seminars and workshops around the world. Finally, he established his own institution “Ibrahim Elfiky International Inc”. He authored numerous bestselling books, audio, video tapes and DVDs in the field of human development. Among many popular books, he published ‘7 Secrets of Personal Power’ and ‘10 Keys to Ultimate Success. Elfiky died in a horrible accident when a fire broke out his apartment building in Cairo on February 10th, 2012.
