Users can search for and watch videos, create a personal YouTube channel. They can also subscribe and follow other channels.

Therefore, there is a wide range of videos available on YouTube. Some examples include homemade music videos, sports bloopers, and other funny events caught on video. People also use YouTube to post instructional videos, such as step-by-step computer help, do-it-yourself guides and other how-to videos.
