Statue of Liberty

The Statue of Liberty is located in New York, the United States of America. It was given to America as a gift from France in 1884, to mark the friendship between France and USA during the American Revolution. It's made of iron structure with copper skin. It is 93 meters high and weighs 225 ton.

The Roman Liberty goddess holds a torch above her head with her right hand which is covered with gold. Lady liberty became an icon of freedom of the United States and a national park tourism destination.

It was designed by *Frederic Auguste Bartholdi* in 1876. The massive iron skeleton of the lady was designed by *Alexandre Gustave Eiffel* who also designed the *Eiffel Tower*. The statue was built and completed in France in 1884. Then it was separated into 350 pieces and transported to New York.

American government declared it as a national monument in 1924. Every year, the statue of Liberty is visited by thousands of people from all over the world.
