TEXT :

Ali Ammar better known by his nickname « Ali La Pointe » was an Algerian revolutionary fighter and guerilla leader of the FLN who fought against the French colonial regime during the battle of Algiers . Ali lived a life of a petty crime and was sentenced to prison when he was recruited by FLN militants and became one of their most trusted and loyal lieutenants in Algiers . On December 28th , 1956 , he was suspected of killing the mayor of Boufarik , Amédée Froger . He was a tireless activist who led teams setting explosives in street lights near bus stops and bombing a dance club that killed 17 people . The revolution leader Yacef Saadi ordered him to hide in separate addresses in the Casbah with Hassiba Ben Bouali , Mohamed Bouhamidi and 'Petit Omar' .



On the 8th of October 1957 , he was given the chance to surrender with his companions but they refused whereupon the house where they were hiding was bombed by the French paratroopers . More than 27 people were killed in the blast .
