It is a football stadium located in Boukhalfa, Tizi Ouzou, , Algeria. Hocine Aït Ahmed Stadium is owned by the Algerian Ministry of Youth and Sport. It can hold over fifty thousand supporters , it is the third largest stadium in Algeria. The stadium was designed by United States-based construction company Atlas Group ,they completed the project in 2023 after 13 years of work as they started the construction on May 15, 2010, it is the new home ground of JS Kabylie, since 2024. Many names have been suggested and discussed among the population; among them the name of Abdelkader Khalef and <u>Mohand Chérif Hannachi</u> because of their legacy and everything they did for JS Kabylie, but only the name of the legendary leader of the FLN during the independence war Hocine Aït Ahmed was chosen to be the name of the new stadium.
