The Second Term Test of English

This is a report of the findings of a survey about reading among the Algerians. People think that the Algerians don't read today and they rarely meet those who had already finished a whole book. I decided to find out whether this was true.

I questioned seventy male and female Algerian university students in order to know what they usually read. When I asked if they read books, all of the students said they always read books that are related to their studies. When I asked if they read other books, twenty five told me they were fond of romantic stories, while thirty five of the informants said they read magazines and newspapers. Only ten of them preferred reading scientific books. Then I asked them if they liked reading a story or watching a film, only twelve said they preferred reading a story while fifty eight enjoyed watching films more than reading.

Surprisingly, my survey showed that the Algerians enjoyed different readings.
