Relying on ChatGPT for homework can have some drawbacks, especially for students. Dr. Zishan Khan, a psychiatrist, says, “Yes, ChatGPT can provide quick answers, but it is not always accurate and lacks the ability to teach students how to analyze problems, think critically, or develop strong study habits.” Overuse of ChatGPT can lead to superficial learning, where students copy answers without understanding the material.

Dr. Khan also warns that relying on AI(Artificial Intelligence) can hinder skill development, such as writing and problem-solving. There are ethical concerns, too, as students may not realize that using ChatGPT without citing sources is unethical. Another issue is misinformation, as ChatGPT can sometimes give incorrect or outdated information.

John Bianchette, an education expert, adds, “At worst, the answer is flat-out wrong and could be missing necessary background knowledge, even when the answer provided seems plausible.” He stresses that relying on AI prevents students from becoming independent thinkers.
