Sandra Fellici , from Italy , reflects on traditional good manners for varied situations and discusses how fast manners are changing . She says :

“I’m filled with childhood memories. When I was five years old, my grandmother , who was the best grandmother in the world , lived with my family .At the time , my father had a business , and my mother used to help him . That’s why I had to stay all day long with my grandmother. She was very kind and loyal to me. (§1)

Unfortunately , in our society today , what we call good manners , or good etiquette, are changing . New generations are becoming more and more impolite. (§2)
