According to "A Global Report-Reducing Disaster Risk, A Challenge for Development" published by the United Nations Development Programme, economical losses due to natural disasters have been increasing in the past 50 years, especially in the Asian countries.

Disasters such as flooding, landslide and debris flow occur frequently due to the global-scale climate change as well as urban developments in Asia. The result is loss of human lives caused by **these** disasters has also been increasing. As one of the places suffered from natural disasters, the government of Taiwan has invested a large amount of resources into researches for disaster prevention, reduction, and response techniques. In particular, the National Science and Technology Centre for Disaster Reduction (**NCDR**) was formed in 2003, and has been providing a variety of research programs related to disaster reduction. These research programs include basic research on the issues about hazards potential analysis, risk assessment, hazards scenario simulation, implementation of hazards reduction plans, education to the general public, supply of insurance and financial incentives, and performance evaluation, etc.

In complying with the "International Cooperation on Research and Training Programs" of the National Science Council of Taiwan R.O.C., **this proposal** is to organize a short-term training program on hazard mitigation with an emphasis on typhoon- and flood-related disasters. The training program is scheduled from March 21 to 25, 2005.
