Nations around the world are preparing for a possible major outbreak of a new deadly virus. The corona virus, which started in the Chinese city of Wuhan, has already killed more than 2700 people till now. It has spread to some countries such as: USA, Japan, Korea, Italy, etc. More than 80239 people have caught the virus and are in hospitals. The World Health Organization (WHO) is meeting to decide whether the outbreak is a global health emergency.

The new corona virus is suspected to have come from illegally traded animals in Wuhan markets. The virus mutated and spread from an animal to a human. Moreover, there are fears it could spread further. Scientists say: “the virus is contagious and can be passed from person to person through the air”. Dr Linfa Wang, a virologist at the Duke-National University of Singapore, said: “the new corona virus is in the same family as SARS, but it's different from SARS”. Common signs of infection include respiratory symptoms, fever, cough, and breathing difficulties. In more severe cases, infection can cause pneumonia, severe acute respiratory syndrome, kidney failure and even death. Fu Ning, a 36 year old woman from Beijing, said: “I feel fearful because there's no cure for the virus up today these days.”

Standard recommendations to prevent infection spread include regular hand washing, covering mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing, thoroughly cooking meat and eggs. Avoid close contact with anyone showing symptoms of respiratory illness such as coughing and sneezing.

To limit the spread of the virus, the Chinese authorities have implemented a number of extraordinary control measures across the country such as: cancelling the New Year celebrations, closing cinemas and the international airport of Wuhan Tianhe, suspending public transportation and enhancing the surveillance system.
