PART ONE : Reading comprehension :

Berbers are the indigenous people of North Africa and west of the Nile valley. They are discontinuously distributed from the Atlantic to the Siwa oasis, in Egypt, and from the Mediterranean to the Niger river. Historically they spoke various Berber languages, which together form a branch of the Afro-Asiatic language family. Today many of them are still keeping their mother tongue, they speak also Arabic and French in the Maghreb, due to the French colonization of this region. Most Berber-speaking people live in Algeria and Morocco, accounting for about 85% of their population. Many Berbers call themselves some variant of the word Imazighen.

The Berbers have lived in North Africa between western Egypt and the Atlantic Ocean for as far as records of the area can go back. Evidence of these early inhabitants of the region are found on the rock art across the Sahara. Berber groups are first mentioned in writing by the ancient Egyptians during the pre-dynastic period and during the new kingdom. The Egyptians, later, fought against these Berber tribes on their western borders. However, Berbers remained the main population of the western desert for a long time.

Berbers were assaulted by many invaders and colonists including the Phoenicians, who founded Carthage, Greeks, Romans, Vandals, Byzantines, Arabs, the French and the Spanish. Despite these aggressions, the highlands of Kabylie and Morocco remained independent.
