Nepotism has been practised by people in power for centuries, but most people engage in nepotism at some time or another. **It** can mean hiring and advancing unqualified or under-qualified family members based simply on the familial relationship. §1

While attitudes toward nepotism vary according to cultural background, nepotism is a sensitive issue in American business. Many companies and individuals consider the practice to be unethical, largely due to its conflict with traditional American values of self-reliance and fairness. §2

Nepotism can seem terribly unfair and it can be very complicated and difficult to fight , particularly in a privately owned business, and sometimes even in the public sector. However, if you have valid concerns about barely qualified employees **who** happen to be family members but are performing corrupt work. Indeed, With your observations and documentation, you may be able to prove that doing favours for one's family members doesn't necessarily do any favours for the company. §3

Nepotism is a threat to an organization and needs to be dealt consciously before letting it creep into the system. In present times, this subject has become a very sensitive issue causing a lot of stress leading to a drop in level of the employees, dissatisfaction in the company and ultimate decision to move on from the present company. §4
