

A/Reading comprehension (08pts)

Do not be tempted by the political, social and economic sophistication that Europe has achieved today - on the surface - there is what **this civilization** hides in terms of excessive bloodshed and abhorrent racism.

Western civilization, throughout its long history, sees the other as a competitor and a potential enemy. You see this clearly when the Europeans arrived in Australia, for example, where only traces of the indigenous peoples remained until they began studying **them** as folklore and anthropology. You can say that about the Native Americans in America when they were completely and bloodily exterminated, and about slavery and racism. You can read hundreds of reports that talk about the millions of Africans who were enslaved and transported from Africa to America. Read the history of the genocide that Andalusian Muslims were subjected to on the hands of European civilization in the Inquisition, to discover beyond any doubt that it was a civilization based on blood, exclusion, and the expulsion of others.

Then read about the refined Islamic civilization, the extent of its brilliance from the first Prophetic society. You will find in **this society** Bilal al-Habashi, Salman al-Farisi, Suhaib al-Rumi, and Abu Bakr al-Arabi, a society that brought together all people. Islamic civilization appeared, carried a wide spectrum of values and principles that made it solid consistent with itself.

European colonialist civilization felt threatened and afraid of the newcomer, so it repeatedly tried to overcome **it** with weapons and military campaigns, through the Crusades.
