Exercise 1:

Implement the following JavaScript functions:

- **increaseFont()**: Increases the paragraph font size by 2px each time the button is clicked.
- **decreaseFont()**: Decreases the paragraph font size by 2px each time the button is clicked. Font size must never go below 10px.
- **decreaseFont()**: Alternates the text color between black and red each time it is clicked.
