3. Make an example that demonstrates hiding/showing an element using the method **slideUp()/slideDown()**

Exercise 3:

In this exercise you should use jQuery for functions,actions and scripts

1. Add a button with class btn btn-primary and the text "Open Modal"
2. Create a Bootstrap modal containing:
 - A title "Confirmation"
 - A body text "Do you want to continue?"
3. Inside the modal, add two buttons:
 - Yes button with the class btn btn-success
 - No button with the class btn btn-secondary
4. When clicking Open Modal, show the modal using jQuery
5. When clicking Yes:
 - Hide the modal
 - Display a Bootstrap alert alert-success with the message "Action confirmed"
6. When clicking No:
 - Hide the modal
 - Display a Bootstrap alert alert-warning with the message "Action canceled"
